

## **Crime and Punishment and Land Use in The Uk**

**Autumn Term 2017**



This pamphlet outlines the content of the curriculum to be covered this term.

### Physical Education PE

Tag Rugby - To be able to evade and tag opponents, to pass and receive a pass at speed, to pass and receive a pass at speed in a game situation, to refine attacking and defending skills, to develop tactics as a team and to apply learned skills in a game of tag rugby

### Arts and Design

Art Illusions - looking at how different artists use perspective in their work and play with perspective to create optical illusions.

### Computing

Online Safety, and through Purplemash creating a webpage and using coding and programming skills to create a simple game.

### Music

Pupils will learn how songs can enhance a celebration and will write a song to celebrate Christmas

### Maths

**Number:** Read, write and locate 5 and 6 digit numbers on a landmarked line; use this to compare/order numbers; recognise the value of each digit. Round any number up to 1 000 000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10 000 and 100 000. Count forwards or backwards in steps of powers of 10 for any given number < 1 000 000. Add/subtract mentally with confidence 4, 5 and 6 digit numbers and to use column method to add and subtract larger numbers. Over areas will be covered over the term

### Reading and Writing

**Writing:** through narrative, non-fiction and poetry. Genres this term include historical stories, explanation texts, recounts and narrative poems. Texts include War Horse, The Highway Man and Revolting Rhymes.

**Grammar and punctuation learning includes:** relative clauses, correct use of punctuation to indicate speech, commas to clarify meaning, using a range of sentence type, perfect form of the verb, accurate usage of apostrophes, and use of colons.

**Reading:** pupils will learn how to carefully select evidence to justify their view, identify key details which support the main idea and make inference from details which are implied.

### Science

Separating mixtures: Pupils will learn how to separate different mixtures by filtering, sieving and evaporation.

Classifying Living Things Micro-organisms: Pupils will learn how to classify different living organisms including micro-organisms.

### Humanities

**RE: What matters to humanists and to Christians?** Pupils will explore some key beliefs of humanists and Christians and how they develop their own.

**History: Crime and Punishment** - Pupils will learn about how crime and punishment has changed over time.

**Geography: Land Use in the UK** - Pupils will learn about how land is used in the UK and how energy is created.
